Acceptance/Rejection letters will be mailed out before the 1st week in June. If you are awarded a scholarship, the award letter will give specific instructions that YOU must complete EVERY semester in order for the scholarship to remain in effect and current; failure to comply with requirements, if you are awarded the scholarship, will result in the loss of your scholarship benefits.

CHANGED FROM LAST YEAR: Students awarded the scholarship for last year need not re-apply scholarship now continues through the attainment of the 42 Hr Gen Ed Block, as long as the student is making adequate academic progress each semester; students in health sciences fields will also be eligible for scholarship of Med Term 1 & 2, and of Human Growth/Development in addition to the 42 Hr Gen Ed Block.
- 4. SCHOLARSHIP CAN BE AWARDED FOR 10<sup>TH</sup> GRADE YEAR NOW (IN ADDITION TO 11<sup>TH</sup> AND 12<sup>TH</sup>)! Current 9<sup>th</sup> graders meeting the following requirement should apply, in addition to current 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> graders. NOTE: 12 cr hr MAX scholarship for 10<sup>th</sup> grade fall / spring semesters combined; restriction is lifted for summer, and for 11<sup>th</sup>/12<sup>th</sup> grade
